Moirā Shire is facing a serious road accident problem, with 23 recorded road deaths in 2023.

Moirā Shire Council, with funding support from the Transport Accident Commission are developing a Road Safety Strategy and Action Plan to help make our roads safer.

We're looking for community, visitors and all road users to complete a questionnaire and share their experiences and concerns regarding road safety to help Council create a comprehensive and actionable road map to improve our roads.
