

Award winning wines, olive oils, organic almonds, local honey and highly sought after fresh produce, the Murray region is paradise for home cooks and foodie friends.



Located less than three hours from Melbourne, between Echuca and Yarrawonga, Cactus Country transports visitors to another world! With a margarita or corona in hand let your imagination run wild as you explore the garden.

Follow one of the eight sandy trails through this 12 acre desert oasis as you wander amongst thousands of incredibly diverse plants from around the world.

Take in the views from the elevated lookout domes, or strike a pose among the cacti for the most instagrammable shots. Families love the spotto trail, and green thumbs will be in plant heaven exploring the onsite nursery.

In spring, the garden explodes with colour during flowering season, and in late October the garden takes on a new life and death at the annual Day of the Dead Festival.

Take a step back in time while sampling organic chocolate and liquorice products. Enjoy watching the team create Belgium chocolates or make your very own giant chocolate.

Tour the distillery and experience Corowa Distilling Co's double distilled whisky, a lighter, and fruitier and grain driven drop. Witness the 'dreaded distiller' create Corowa's own single malt whisky, sourced from local barley in the stunning copper stills.

Enjoy breakfast, lunch, coffee, cakes and of course whisky while taking in the view of this historic setting.



Kewstoke Olive Estate

Kewstoke is a family run and passion driven Olive Estate, producing extra virgin olive oil, infused oils and olive soap that are grown and processed on site.

The Kewstoke property has been in the Greco family since 1999 and in 2001 the family planted 4,000 olive trees on 50 acres, beginning their olive oil venture.

Purity, freshness and quality is at the heart of the father and son operation. Kewstoke Olive Estate uses traditional processing methods that have been passed down the Greco family from generation to generation, originating in Italy.

Visitors are welcome to the family-run farm and you will also find their produce online and at local farmers markets.













Monichino Wines


